






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### **Activity 2**

## Introduction to e-education platforms and resources

Topic Covered	Introduction to e-education platforms and resources
Learning Outcomes and Competences that can be acquired Duration	<ul> <li>Get acquainted with the existence of online education</li> <li>Learn about the existence of different types of online education and courses</li> <li>Learn how to find different courses and online platforms</li> <li>60 minutes</li> </ul>
Kind of Method  Required Materials	<ul> <li>presentation</li> <li>interactive discussion</li> <li>hands-on exercise</li> <li>non-formal education</li> <li>laptop</li> <li>internet connection</li> </ul>
Learning Setting and Activity Description	For this activity, the educator/trainer introduces the topic, with a general, interactive discussion, before proceeding to the more practical elements.  1. Introductory presentation with some questions to break the ice. The trainer can lead an oral discussion and/or use an online platform to collect and visualise the responses, e.g. Kahoot, Mentimeter, etc.  The trainer can then look at the totality of the answers and discuss the issues and perceptions of the audience concerning e-education.  Examples of questions that can be used to introduce the session  (https://www.mentimeter.com/app/presentation/al25gus3ybeewpqbgtomfg5h1wwdxtr6/4whfu3t1p5fg/edit):  Which of these platforms do you know?  2. Next, the trainer asks the participants to get into groups and search for possible online courses. After the research, they are asked to describe the course and explain the benefits of attending such a course.
Activity Evaluation/ Reflection	The audience would come to comprehend what an online course is and would be able to search for one themselves.  The questions used to trigger the beginning of the session would be once again made, and the answers before and after the activity would be compared in order to see how much the students learned from it.
